CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Mike Cole called the meeting to order at 10:01 a.m. and led the Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance.

▶1. NORTH FLORIDA TPO MINUTES OF OCTOBER 12, 2023

Betsy Condon moved to approve the Consent Agenda; Mark McManus seconded; motion unanimously carried.

AGENDA

A. FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT

Representing the Finance Committee, Angela Session reported the September financials have been accepted.

Ms. Session asked for questions. There were no questions at this time.

►B. FDOT REQUESTS AMENDING THE FY 2023/24 THROUGH FY 2027/28 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)

Victoria Kutney presented the following amendments to the Transportation Improvement Program for FY 2023/24 through FY 2027/28.

- 447125-1 SR 109 (University Blvd.) from SR 13 (San Jose Blvd.) to I-95 Resurfacing – Duval County *Non-SIS*
- 447126-1 SR 228A (Emerson St. Xway) and SR 126 (Emerson St. Ext.) Resurfacing Duval County *Non-SIS*

• 422938-8 – SR 23 (First Coast Xway) from East of CR 2209 to East of CR 16A Spur – New Road Construction – St. Johns County *SIS*

Ms. Kutney asked for questions. There were no questions at this time.

Fernando Acosta-Rua moved to approve the FDOT's request to amend the FY 2023/24 through FY 2027/28 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); Soo Gilvarry seconded; motion unanimously carried.

C. <u>FDOT TENTATIVE WORK PROGRAM FOR FY 2025/26 THROUGH</u> FY 2028/29

Victoria Kutney of FDOT presented the FDOT's Tentative Work Program for FY 2025/26 through FY 2028/29.

Ms. Kutney asked for questions.

- Jeff Sheffield informed the Board increased costs, less than desirable bidding creating cost increases, along with a state-wide program is significantly impacting the Work Program. The I-95 project is being subjected to delays to address these concerns. However, there may be opportunities to help the early phases of some of these projects to continue to move forward.
- Betsy Condon wanted to know if we should ask our legislators and the Governor to allocate additional funds for some of these projects.
 - Mr. Sheffield responded it is the legislature and administration that are driving a lot of this impact. The Moving Florida Forward program was initiated through the legislature to address significant projects of statewide interest. The legislature funded \$4 billion last year none of which was in our district. There is a need for funds to keep that program moving forward. Districts need to come up with those funds to make it work.
- Larry Parks informed the Board FDOT has reduced the scope of projects, cut projects in half, moved projects out, etc. to try and address this issue.
- Fernando Acosta-Rua asked if there has been any stabilization in any of these projects.
 - Mr. Parks responded some of the resurfacing projects are starting to stabilize. We have fewer bidders on projects as well.
- Jim Knight commented that prices have doubled over the last four years. Revenues have stayed constant. We have kept everything in the five years except one project that is now in the sixth year.

 Christian Whitehurst expressed his thanks for staff and FDOT being candid with the Board about the state of the projects. Mr. Whitehurst wanted to know if he should inform his constituents of the revised schedule for the First Coast Expressway. Mr. Whitehurst wanted to know if it is being pushed out to 2031 or 2032.

Jim Knight responded if you look at straight days 2029 is correct. When we report that we don't account for holidays, weather days, delays, etc. The reality is it will be 2031 for completion.

D. <u>LIST OF PRIORITY PROJECTS (LOPP)</u>

Clark Letter informed the group staff is now soliciting projects for the annual List of Priority Projects (LOPP). This is a candidate list of projects for the new fifth year of FDOT's Five Year Work Program. Submission of initial priority projects are due no later than January 26, 2024. This will enable TPO staff to prepare a first draft of the LOPP for the February meetings, with the expectation of adoption in March.

Mr. Letter asked for questions. There were no questions at this time.

E. <u>UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM (UPWP) FY 2024/25 THROUGH</u> FY 2025/26

Clark Letter informed the group staff is now soliciting study requests to consider for inclusion in FY 2024/25. These projects are located in "Section 5 – Special Projects" section of the UPWP and are executed by a TPO General Consultant. Studies for consideration should be submitted no later than January 26, 2024. This will enable TPO staff to prepare a first draft of the LOPP for the February meetings, with the expectation of adoption in May.

The UPWP is the TPO's two year tasked based budget. Bi-annually, TPO staff updates the UPWP as required by state and federal regulation. The UPWP outlines all major transportation planning activities to be undertaken by the TPO for the two-year planning period beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2026.

Mr. Letter asked for questions.

 Jeff Sheffield informed the Board these studies are done on behalf of the member counties and usually equates to 10-12 per year. This is the ROI on your assessments.

F. SMART NORTH FLORIDA UPDATE

Clayton Levins gave the following update.

- Continuing our data coordination program with the University of Florida's Masters of Data Science students. A few projects they are working on are as follows:
 - o LISC Jacksonville
 - Community Foundation for Northeast Florida Leveraging machine learning for property appraisals to help address our region's housing crisis.
 - City of Palm Coast and City of Neptune Beach Digitize physical assets for resiliency studies.
- Soo Gilvarry wanted to know what topic SNF is working with.

Mr. Levins responded we are working with their Community Development Officer. It is a wholistic project analyzing data from the property appraisers office, third-party data providers, etc. They are performing trend analysis on every project in Jacksonville. This will help LISC and the Community Foundation to make decisions to alleviate the pressure points around our region.

• Ju'Coby Pittman wanted to know if there would be an assessment of transportation in those areas.

Mr. Levins responded this is one of the gaps in providing affordable housing to our citizens. These broader elements could be added as we continue to aggregate this data moving forward.

 Debbie Buckland wanted to know if the students within this program are being paid \$80,000 individually.

Mr. Levins responded the students are not being paid to participate in this program. That is just the value of what we are getting.

G. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Jeff Sheffield gave the following update.

- TPO's Federal Certification will be held in May 2024.
- MPOAC Institute will be hosting a session in 2024. Please let me know if you are interested in attending.
- LRTP is moving forward. Please continue to work on your county's priorities.

Mr. Sheffield thanked FDOT for their continued support and partnership to move projects forward.

H. SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION'S REPORT

Jim Knight informed the Board FDOT is converting several design-build jobs to conventional construction jobs. The key is to have projects "shovel ready".

I. AUTHORITY REPORTS

Fernando Acosta-Rua – **Jacksonville Aviation Authority** – Construction of the security checkpoint should be complete this week.

Soo Gilvarry – **JAXPORT** – New environmental friendly locomotive will soon serve the Talleyrand Marine Terminal. Carnival Cruise will offer cruises to Celebration Key, New Grand Bahama beginning in 2025. Recently facilitated the movement of approximately 877 pieces of military equipment, including dozens of aircraft, through the Blount Island Marine Terminal.

Debbie Buckland – Jacksonville Transportation Authority - October 16 JTA held its Regional Capital Infrastructure Summit, which brought together small businesses and prime contractors who were interested in working with the JTA. Professional services, construction companies, and small businesses across Northeast Florida and beyond were able to connect with JTA leadership, government executives, prime contractors, and other business leaders. The summit included a variety of networking events and breakout sessions including a Shark Tank-style competition and one-on-one networking sessions for Local Small Business Enterprises (LSBE) to meet with prime contractors in the region. The summit provided an opportunity for the JTA to showcase its five-year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) and MobilityWorks 2.0 Program. Both plans aim to enhance Jacksonville's major infrastructure, construction, and road projects.

The JTA held a ribbon cutting ceremony October 24 for the completed Alta Drive JTAMobilityWorks project. The Alta Drive roadway improvements include widening the existing roadway to a six-lane, divided roadway from the I-295 exit to Faye Road, a four-lane divided roadway to Ashgrove Road and a five-lane roadway to Burkit Lane. The project also includes improved drainage system, signage and signalization, improved lighting, and new pedestrian sidewalks and bike lanes. Alta Drive is one of JTAMobilityWorks projects aimed at improving neighborhoods and communities throughout Northeast Florida, creating more robust mobility options for residents.

The JTA, City of Jacksonville, and Groundwork Jacksonville have executed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the future design and development of the Emerald Trail. The MOU applies to the five remaining trail segments to be funded, in part, by \$132 million from the Local Option Gas Tax. The JTA and Groundwork Jacksonville will collectively collaborate to manage and oversee trail design, permitting, and procurement, in accordance with the Emerald Trail Master Plan Groundwork Jacksonville will continue to lead community outreach and engagement. The JTA and Groundwork will jointly negotiate fees, scope of work, and delivery schedules with design professionals. JTA will lead and

procure permitting and construction. The Emerald Trail project is part of a shared vision to rejuvenate our neighborhoods, foster a stronger sense of community, and instill vibrancy in the heart of this city. We're excited to partner with Groundwork Jacksonville to design and build the five remaining segments of the Emerald Trail.

The JTA expanded service hours November 1 for the St. Johns Ferry in response to growing demand. Funded, in part, by a Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) grant, the Ferry now runs from 6 a.m. to 8:45 p.m., extending two hours during the week and one hour during the weekend. The St. Johns River Ferry connects the north and south ends of State Road A1A in Duval County, linking Mayport Village and Ft. George Island via a pleasant sail across the St. Johns River. The 0.9-mile voyage crosses the St. Johns River 2.5 miles inland of the river's mouth. The trip takes roughly 5 minutes and departs every half hour.
