 Lynn Rutkowski wanted to know the FY 2020/21 funding amount for the SR A1A at 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue North - Pedestrian Safety Improvement project.

Ms. Martinage responded that it is \$35, which represents in-house design funds.

Phong Nguyen moved to approve the FDOT's request to amend the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for FY 2020/21 through FY 2024/25; Ed Lehman seconded; motion unanimously carried.

• Phong Nguyen suggested that each county program money annually to leverage funding to have a study conducted through the TPO.

Jeff Sheffield responded that counties are realizing the ability to leverage local funds to conduct these studies. The TPO receives approximately \$400,000 annually in local assessments. The planning studies are our way of giving back to the counties that total between \$1.4 – 1.5 million.

#### D. <u>DRAFT PROJECT SECTIONS FOR THE FY 2021/22 THROUGH FY 2025/26</u> TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)

Wanda Forrest presented the draft project sections for the FY 2021/22 through FY 2025/26 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The complete draft will be presented next month, with approval requested in June.

Ms. Forrest asked for questions.

 Ed Lehman commented that in FY 2024/25 the First Coast Expressway is showing \$6 million in the first segment and \$5 million in the second segment with an outlier four years from now. Mr. Lehman wanted to know what this represents.

Ms. Martinage responded that she will email that information to Mr. Lehman.

#### E. FDOT AREA PROJECTS UPDATE PRESENTATION

Hampton Ray of FDOT provided a brief update on the major projects within the area.

Mr. Ray asked for questions.

- Ed Lehman wanted to know if there is a shared use path planned for the Shands Bridge.
  - Mr. Ray responded that he will get back to Mr. Lehman with an answer.
  - Ed Lehman responded that Clay County requested a shared use path on this bridge.
- Phong Nguyen wanted to know what the completion date is for the First Coast Expressway.
  - Mr. Ray responded that he will get back to Mr. Nguyen with an answer.
- Phong Nguyen wanted to know what FDOT is doing on the Buckman Bridge.
  - Mr. Ray responded that this is a safety improvement project that includes adding additional overhead signage that will indicate lanes that are closed and lanes that are best for continued travel.

- Phong Nguyen wanted to know if this project includes adding an additional lane and restriping.
  - Mr. Ray responded that is not included in this project.

#### F. SMART NORTH FLORIDA UPDATE

Jeff Sheffield gave the following update.

- SNF has hired Clayton Levins as its Executive Director.
- SNF did not receive the National Science Foundation for broadband deployment grant. SNF is awaiting a decision on our grant application to the Florida Broadband Office to install broadband on the east side of Jacksonville.
- Rueuben Franklin wanted to know if the Smart North Florida report card is comparing us to other areas/regions.
  - Mr. Sheffield responded that there are community-wide report cards that include matrix that we could use as a benchmark.

#### G. OLD BUSINESS

None at this time.

#### H. NEW BUSINESS

- Denise Bunnewith informed the group that House Bill 1113 and Senate Bill 1412 propose to change the flashing yellow beacons at mid-block crossings to flashing red. The rationale is that the flashing yellow gives pedestrians a false sense of security.
- Reuben Franklin commented that if it is approved then the flashing yellow beacons will be changed to red.
- Reuben Franklin wanted to know if the beacon is flashing red, does it require the car to come to a complete stop.
  - Ms. Bunnewith responded that the car will be required to make a complete stop.
- Ed Lehman wanted to know if the beacons will be flashing red even when there are no pedestrians.
  - Ms. Bunnewith responded that she is not sure.
- Reuben Franklin asked about COJ's scooter pilot program.

Mr. Sheffield responded that three or four vendors placed scooters within a geographically fenced area to prevent them from leaving the downtown area. COJ will have all the data generated by the ridership.

• Jeff Sheffield wanted to know the status of St. Augustine's bike share program.

Mr. Franklin responded that we hired a company in April 2020. Due to the pandemic, the program has been off to a slow start. Currently, we are only doing bike share and are promoting mobility hubs that will allow us to have more oversight control.

The Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) is the task-based budget of the North Florida Transportation Planning Organization (TPO).
