CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Sparks welcomed everyone and called the Technical Advisory Committee meeting to order at 10:09 a.m. Introductions were made around the room.

Reuben Franklin moved to approve the JTA's request to amend the FY 2024/25 – FY 2028/29 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); Michael Grunwald seconded; motion unanimously carried.

D. <u>DRAFT JOINT CERTIFICATION OF THE METROPOLITAN</u> <u>TRANSPORTATION PLANNING PROCESS</u>

Clark Letter presented the draft Joint Certification of the Metropolitan Transportation Planning Process.

Mr. Letter asked for questions. There were no questions at this time.

Steve Smith moved to approve the Joint Certification of the Metropolitan Transportation Planning Process; Reuben Franklin seconded; motion unanimously carried.

E. TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) FY 2025/26 – FY 2029/30

Elizabeth De Jesus informed the group the schedule for the TIP process will be accelerated. In past years, we have received two releases of the TIP project data from FDOT. The initial release typically occurred in March, allowing the first draft of the TIP to be distributed in April for review. A second release followed in April, enabling us to distribute a refined draft in May. Our goal has always been to provide an iterative process allowing early and often opportunity for you to review the information.

FDOT has informed the TPO that starting this year only a single annual release of the TIP project data will be provided. We are currently scheduled to receive this year's TIP data during the second week of April. This change in FDOT's schedule will require adjustments to our internal processes and timeline for sharing the TIP. We understand this may also impact your workflows. We want to assure you that we will work diligently to provide you access to the TIP draft as quickly as possible. We plan to distribute a link to the draft before our meeting May 8.

A formal TIP presentation will be given at the May meeting, and we will be seeking your approval in June.

Ms. De Jesus asked for questions.

- Doug Conkey asked if it is possible to track the differential in public participation based on specific metrics.
 - Mr. Sheffield responded we will get the number of "hits" to the website. Also, the virtual TIP meetings have worked out well and have more participation than the previous format.
- Doug Conkey asked if our area local governments will include the meeting schedule on their social media outlets.

Ms. De Jesus responded each county will post this information on their social media outlets.

F. SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL ASSISTANCE (UPWP)

Thalia Fuste gave an update on the Safe Routes to School program.

Ms. Fuste asked for questions.

 Chris LeDew invited Ms. Fuste to the next School Safety Committee monthly meeting. Representatives from the Duval County School Board Transportation Office, FDOT, the Jacksonville Sheriff Office, and the City will attend.

- Doug Conkey asked if it is possible to address the safety concerns for kids walking and biking to and from school before it is built.
 - Ms. Fuste responded the City has ordinances in place requiring developers to put in sidewalks near a school when building a new development.
- Richard Smith asked if this would supplement or replace a current or ongoing effort for a sidewalk.
 - Ms. Fuste responded the funding takes several years and a sidewalk request usually takes approximately five or more years for completion.
- Richard Smith asked if this is a grant submittal.
 - Ms. Fuste responded it is up to the school, and we will help them with a grant application submittal.
- Michael Grunwald commented a new school has zero interest in the traffic network in the area. Often a school is put in an area that was not planned or zoned for a school.
- Laurie Santana commented COJ put some schools in their list of priority projects and would like to know if the TPO would like more schools for consideration.
 - Ms. Fuste responded we could look at the schools and make sure this is the right time for that school. We welcome adding schools to this program.

G. CORE TO COAST TRAIL ALIGNMENT STUDY PRESENTATION

Martha Moore of Benesch gave a brief presentation on the Core to Coast Trail Alignment Study.

Ms. Moore asked for questions.

 Doug Conkey asked if a conservation easement could be used to get a trail approved.

Ms. Moore responded there are more conservation easements in Clay County. This particular area of Jacksonville is built out.

H. SMART NORTH FLORIDA

Garreth Rempel of Trainfo gave a brief update on the data flow and integration into Google Maps.

Mr. Rempel asked for questions.

 Doug Conkey asked if there is a way to connect with the railroad if first responders see a train coming and need to cross the tracks.

Mr. Levins responded the rail companies will not adjust their schedules. Trainfo has integration capabilities with the first responders' dispatch systems that can inform them so they can reroute if necessary.

REQUIRED ACTION: APPROVAL BY RESOLUTION (2025-4)

The Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) is the task-based budget of the North Florida Transportation Planning Organization (TPO). The format of the two-year document is loosely outlined in federal guidance and more specifically defined by the Florida Department of Transportation. The UPWP includes administrative tasks including developing the UPWP, a number of required work tasks such as the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), Congestion Management Process (CMP), Long Range Transportation Plan, and other related planning tasks including transit planning most of which is performed by the Jacksonville Transportation Authority.

Section 5, Special Projects is being amended with Resolution 2025-4 to add the following:

- Task 5.11—Protected Bicycle Lanes Study
