C. <u>AMENDMENT OF THE UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM (UPWP) FOR</u> FY 2024/25 – FY 2025/26 (ADDITION OF SECOND YEAR PROJECTS)

Clark Letter presented the amendment of the Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) for FY 2024/25 – FY 2025/26 (Addition of Second Year Projects).

The UPWP is the TPO's task-based budget. The format of the two-year document is loosely outlined in federal guidance and more specifically defined by FDOT. The UPWP includes administrative tasks including developing the UPWP, a number of required work tasks such as the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), Congestion Management Process (CMP), Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP), and other related planning tasks including transit planning most of which is performed by the JTA.

- Laurie Santana asked what the \$600,000 in funding is for in the emergency signal for JFRD project. Ms. Santana asked if the \$1.2 million is for construction.
 - Mr. Knight responded the \$600,000 is for design and \$1.2 million is for construction.
- Laurie Santana asked why nothing is planned for FY 2026/27 for this project.
 - Mr. Knight responded because we want to give them ample time to do the signal design.

^{*}Tasks funded either entirely or partially from FHWA carryforward funding. These funds will not become available for approval until July 2025.

G. ATLANTIC BEACH ROUNDABOUT FEASIBILITY STUDY PRESENTATION

Martha Moore and Ryan Thady of Benesch presented the Atlantic Beach Roundabout Feasibility Study.

Ms. Moore asked for questions.

Reuben Franklin asked what the public engagement is for this project.

Ms. Moore responded we held a town hall meeting with Mayor Ford and citizens of Atlantic Beach in January.

Mayor Ford thanked the TPO for doing the intersection study.

Mr. Sheffield commented the residents of Atlantic Beach were receptive to the results of the study.

 Mike Grunewald commented 15 percent of the crashes involved either a bicycle or pedestrian. Mr. Grunewald asked what elements are proposed to address bicycle and pedestrian safety.

Ms. Moore responded we are proposing a peanut roundabout that will pull back the crosswalks and give bicyclists a way to get to the center of the roundabout and continue to the other side.

Clayton Levins gave the following update.

- Archer First Response demonstration given to first responders and 911 dispatchers within the region two weeks ago at the TPO.
- SNF Pilot Sponsorship Program supporting local governments in innovation
 - o A process has been developed for "use case" submission
 - o Looking for "Use Cases" in the following areas:
 - Infrastructure pavement management, asset inventory, parking, etc.
 - Flooding/Resiliency

- Transportation Safety
- Process Improvement Technology including data analytics, AI and digital twins
- Disaster Response
- Public Utilities
- Funding is limited and applications are being considered on a rolling basis and available funding.
