In addition to sharing the TIP meeting information with TPO Committees and county/city contacts, our public involvement efforts included promoting the virtual presentations through the TPO's e-newsletter, local newspaper advertising, the TPO's social media and other local media outlets. A web-based public involvement tool was used to gather input.

Terry Shaw of Kimley-Horn presented the Cheswick Oaks Avenue/Oakleaf Plantation Parkway Corridor Study.

Mr. Shaw asked for questions.

- Doug Conkey asked who would be financially responsible to pay for the "blue" proposed route.
 - Mr. Shaw responded there is no funding available at this time.
- Richard Smith commented the question is how we present this project to show it has a regional impact and a positive impact on the FDOT's system.
 - Mr. Sheffield responded it would be beneficial to get this project on the TPO's priority list to seek federal appropriations. Also, scale it to a reasonable segmentation that allows it to be funded with traditional funding mechanisms.
- Richard Smith commented Clay County will be opening the first divergent diamond within the turnpike road system in the next three weeks.
- Doug Conkey asked if the intersection of Blanding Blvd. is a hybrid diverging diamond.
 - Mr. Smith responded it is a displaced left turn.

THIS AMENDMENT TO THE FDOT/METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION AGREEMENT (Amendment) is made and entered into on this day of , by and between the STATE OF FLORIDA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (Department), an agency of the State of Florida, whose address is Office of the District Secretary, 1109 South Marion Avenue, Lake City, FL 32025 and the North Florida Transportation Planning Organization (MPO), whose address is 980 North Jefferson Street, Jacksonville, FL 32209, and whose System for Award Management (SAM) Number is: J8MJW3KNYQS7 (collectively the "parties").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Department and the MPO on May 29th, 2024 entered into an FDOT/Metropolitan Planning Organization Agreement (Agreement), whereby the Department passed through Federal funds to the MPO to assist the MPO in performing transportation planning activities set forth in its Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP).

WHEREAS, the Parties have agreed to modify the Agreement on the terms and conditions set forth herein.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants in this Amendment, the Agreement is amended as follows:

1. Paragraph 5 of the Agreement is amended to reflect:

Project Cost: The total budgetary ceiling for the Project is \$7,473,219. The budget, including tasks, is summarized below and detailed in the UPWP, Exhibit "A". The budget may be modified by mutual agreement as provided for in paragraph 9, Amendments.

The Department's performance and obligation to pay under this Agreement is contingent upon an annual appropriation by the Legislature. No work shall begin before the Agreement is fully executed and a "Letter of Authorization" is issued by the Department. The total of all authorizations shall not exceed the budgetary ceiling established for this agreement and shall be completed within the term of this Agreement:

REQUIRED ACTION: APPROVAL BY RESOLUTION (2025-7)

The Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) is the task-based budget of the North Florida Transportation Planning Organization (TPO). The format of the two-year document is loosely outlined in federal guidance and more specifically defined by the Florida Department of Transportation. The UPWP includes administrative tasks, a number of required work tasks such as the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), Congestion Management Process (CMP), Long Range Transportation Plan, and other related planning tasks including transit planning most of which is performed by the Jacksonville Transportation Authority.

In May 2025, the UPWP was amended to include additional year two special studies. A portion of these studies identified the use of closeout funds from the prior UPWP. These funds are now available to be amended into the UPWP with Resolution 2025-7 to add funding to the following sub-tasks:
