#### **CALL TO ORDER**

Chairman Bolla called the meeting to order at 10:04 a.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### PUBLIC COMMENT

None at this time.

Daniel Bean moved to approve the Consent Agenda; Christian Whitehurst seconded; motion unanimously carried.

#### **AGENDA**

#### A. FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT

Representing the Finance Committee, Angela Session reported that the July financials have been accepted.

## ►B. PROJECT RECOMMENDATIONS FOR SU FUNDING FOR FY 2023/24 THROUGH FY 2027/28

Jeff Sheffield presented the project recommendations for SU funding for FY 2023/24 through FY 2027/28. A draft was presented to the TPO Board last month.

The Baptist Hospital technology study has been deleted from the list.
 FDOT will fund this study with planning funds and is anticipated to begin within the next few weeks. The \$500,000 earmarked for this project is being held for potential cost overruns for the remaining projects on the list.

Mr. Sheffield asked for questions. There were no questions at this time.

Christian Whitehurst moved to approve the project recommendations for SU funding for FY 2023/24 through FY 2027/28; Daniel Bean seconded; motion unanimously carried.

## ►C. PROJECT RECOMMENATIONS FOR CMAQ FUNDING FOR FY 2023/24 THROUGH FY 2027/28

Jeff Sheffield presented the project recommendations for CMAQ funding for FY 2023/24 through FY 2027/28. A draft was presented to the TPO Board last month.

Mr. Sheffield asked for questions.

 Christian Whitehurst asked if the US-1@ Race Track Road project dollars reflect inflation.

Mr. Sheffield responded that the dollars reflected on the chart is FDOT's current estimate for the project. There could be some inflationary problems, which is why we are holding the \$500,000 in funding.

- Mr. Sheffield informed the group that the federal Carbon Reduction Program mirrors the CMAQ program. The Carbon Reduction Program requires 65 percent of the funds be spent in the urbanized area. From an annual funding perspective, it is estimated to be \$2.3 to \$2.5 million. Next year we will have \$3.8 to \$4 million combined funding to support a single project. These funds are allocated federally; however, the state does not have authorization to spend those dollars yet. Therefore, next year we will be doing two years of funding.
- Mr. Sheffield asked the Board for permission, if the Carbon Reduction funds become available within the next 30 days, to advance a project on the CMAQ list.

Chairman Bolla asked the Board if anyone has an issue with Mr. Sheffield's proposal.

No opposition was given to Mr. Sheffield's proposal.

 Nancy Sikes-Kline commented this is a wise choice to proceed in that direction. Ms. Sikes-Kline also commented that in the future we should look at what kinds of projects are eligible for the carbon reduction funds. Mr. Sheffield responded that we would not want to do anything that the Board has not taken action on. We would only advance a project that has already been approved by the Board.

Daniel Bean moved to approve the project recommendations for CMAQ funding for FY 2023/24 through FY 2027/28; Ari Jolly seconded; motion unanimously carried.

## D. <u>STRATEGIC INTERMODEL SYSTEM (SIS) POLICY PLAN</u> PRESENTATION

David Tyler of FDOT gave a brief presentation on the Strategic Intermodal System (SIS) Policy Plan.

Mr. Tyler asked for questions.

- Mr. Sheffield informed the Board that the SIS program has been around for 20 years. This is 75 percent of the state's funds going to the designated roadways within the SIS. This leaves 85 percent of the roads within the state not within the SIS. MPOs have been asking that roadways not within the SIS that provide benefit to the system be eligible for the funding.
- Nancy Sikes-Kline asked if you know what the process will be to get new roads in the network.

Mr. Sheffield responded that he does not yet know what that process will be. Some roads may never need to be in the SIS if we have the flexibility to invest in them because it improves the existing network.

#### E. SMART NORTH FLORIDA UPDATE

Clayton Levins gave the following update.

- Last year, the University of Florida's Masters of Data Science students did a few projects with SNF. This year 30 students signed up to participate. A few projects they will be working on are as follows:
  - Neptune Beach Parking Management and data analytics with Storm Sensor
  - UNF Hunger Network Program
  - o NEFL Regional Council Report Card
  - LISC Jacksonville project to be determined
  - DuPont Fund and Community Foundation project to be determined

#### F. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Mr. Sheffield gave the following update.

For a number of years, there has been guidelines establishing the need for performance measures among the states. At the state level, performance measures are done relative to the transportation system in support of the federal requirements. Green House Omissions is being added as a performance measure. FDOT's Central Office is drafting a response, with the support of the state-wide MPOs, to the addition of this performance measure.

#### Some of the points are:

- o Targets and timelines are prescriptive. FDOT is asking for more flexibility to address the characteristics of each state.
- The targets need to be set by October 1 and comments are due by October 12. FDOT is asking for an extension.
- Establish a baseline and show decline in emissions. This does not take into account Florida's increase in population and vehicle miles traveled.
- MPOs are to establish their own targets. We are a planning organization, so to hold us accountable for a deliverable by another agency is an issue.
- There are 27 MPOs in the state and ten urbanized areas. This would result in 115 new targets. Every MPO has the ability to set their own targets.
- Chairman Bolla asked if there are any repercussions if the targets are not met.

Mr. Sheffield responded that this process is looking into that, as well as several other issues.

#### G. <u>SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION'S REPORT</u>

Jim Knight informed the group that FDOT received bids last week for the Shands Bridge replacement project. FDOT's estimate for this project was \$420 million and the low bid came in at \$600 million. Staff is reviewing the bid to see if it can be awarded and where the additional funds would come from.

Fernando Acosta-Rua asked what the project entails.

Mr. Knight responded that the project will take the existing two-lane Shands Bridge and replace it with a new four-lane bridge with a multi-use trail over the St. Johns River.

Kristen Burke asked if there was any way to expand the existing bridge.

Mr. Knight responded that the bridge is still in good shape. However, it is over 60 years old and limits the vertical traffic to 35 feet. This prevents economic development south of the bridge.

#### H. AUTHORITY REPORTS

**Fernando Acosta-Rua** – **Jacksonville Aviation Authority** – Cecil Field's Boeing project will construct 400,000 square feet of buildings for military aircrafts. It will open in August 2023 and will double Cecil Field's annual revenue. The goal is to make Cecil Field a hub for defense work.

**Daniel Bean – JAXPORT –** James Bennett has been promoted to Chief Operating Officer. JaxPort is hosting the Paper Product Industry Transportation Symposium September 18-20. Two of the lead Asian ocean carriers have made JaxPort their first stop instead of the last. JaxPort has been voted the top port in the nation for value and the top port on the east coast in customer satisfaction.

Mike Cole – Nassau County Ocean Highway and Port Authority – The new owner/operator has hit the ground running. Tonnage is expected to hit a record high this month.

Ari Jolly – Jacksonville Transportation Authority - The U.S. Department of Transportation awarded the JTA \$15.4 million through the Low or No Emissions Buses & Bus Facilities Grant Program. The Low-No Grant Program assists agencies in the financing of buses and bus facilities capital projects, including replacing, rehabilitating, purchasing or leasing buses or related equipment, and rehabilitating, purchasing, constructing or leasing bus-related facilities. The program provides funding to state and local governmental authorities for the purchase or lease of zero-emission and low-emission transit buses, including acquisition, construction, and leasing of required supporting facilities. Using this funding, the JTA will retire 21 diesel buses that have reached or exceeded their useful life and replace them with the CNG-powered buses. The JTA is also preparing for the next generation of carbon neutral electric buses by building the necessary infrastructure to support six additional battery electric buses funded through the State of Florida's Volkswagen Settlement Program.

In August, the JTA Board of Directors unanimously approved a permanent expansion of My Ride 2 School, which provides free fares to Duval County public and private middle and high school students. The program launched as a pilot in

January during school hours and was expanded over the summer to 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

The JTA Board also approved free fares for full and part-time college students attending an accredited college or university. The free college fare pilot was first launched during the Fall 2021 semester. College students can sign up through our mobile ticketing application, Token Transit, following the steps to verify their enrollment through ID.Me. Once verified, students can access and download their mobile passes through the Token Transit mobile app for iOS and/or Android smart mobile devices.

• Christian Whitehurst asked if the students that are utilizing the service are within a two-mile radius of a school.

Ms. Jolly responded any student in Duval County can ride the bus for free.

Terrance Freeman expressed his excitement for the program. This program is available to all children in Duval County. Mr. Freeman asked if JTA has started discussions with The Working Poor to develop a program to offer access to jobs.

Ms. Jolly responded that we are always evaluating programs and initiatives, and will pass this information along to staff.

Chairman Bolla commented that it is a problem when we offer a program, but the bus does not go there.

**Reba Ludlow – St. Augustine-St. Johns County Airport Authority** – Elite Airways is no longer operating out of our airport, as the grant money is expanded. We have a grant to repair taxiway B for commercial aviation. There is a two-year waiting list on building hangars due to lack of money.

Matt Schellhorn (for Captain Jeff Hill) U.S. Navy – Change of Command at Mayport has taken place. NAS Mayport is the new homeport of the U.S.S Mason.
