Chairman Bolla called the meeting to order at 10:04 a.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

PUBLIC COMMENT

None at this time.

Daniel Bean moved to approve the Consent Agenda; LeAnna Cumber seconded; motion unanimously carried.

AGENDA

A. <u>FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT</u>

Representing the Finance Committee, Angela Session reported that the May and June financials have been accepted.

►B. JTA REQUESTS AMENDING THE FY 2021/22 THROUGH FY 2025/26 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)

Palmer Kuder presented the following amendment to the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for FY 2021/22 through FY 2025/26.

Duval County

• 4242367-2 – JTA Renewable Energy Generation for Electric Vehicles

Ms. Kuder asked for questions. There were no questions at this time.

Daniel Bean moved to approve the JTA's request to amend the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for FY 2021/22 through FY 2025/26; Christian Whitehurst seconded; motion unanimously carried.

►C. FDOT REQUESTS AMENDING THE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) FOR FY 2022/23 THROUGH FY 2026/27 TO INCLUDE PROJECTS IN THE ROLL FORWARD REPORT

Mari Schwabacher presented the amendment to the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for FY 2022/23 through FY 2026/27.

The Roll Forward Amendment includes projects or phases of projects that were approved in the FY 2022/23 through FY 2026/27 TIP, but were authorized or begun prior to July 1, 2022. These projects then "Roll Forward" into the first year of the new FY 2022/23 through FY 2026/27 TIP.

Ms. Schwabacher asked for questions. There were no questions at this time.

Daniel Bean moved to approve the FDOT's request to amend the FY 2022/23 through FY 2026/27 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to include projects in the Roll Forward Report; LeAnna Cumber seconded; motion unanimously carried.

D. <u>DRAFT PROJECT RECOMMENDATIONS FOR SU FUNDING FOR FY</u> 2023/24 THROUGH FY 2027/28

Jeff Sheffield presented the draft project recommendations for SU funding for FY 2023/24 through FY 2027/28.

Mr. Sheffield asked for questions.

 LeAnna Cumber wanted to know the timeframe for the Southbank FEC Vehicle Reroute Study.

Mr. Sheffield responded this is a six-month study beginning July 1, 2023.

E. <u>DRAFT PROJECT RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CMAQ FUNDING FOR</u> FY 2023/24 THROUGH FY 2027/28

Jeff Sheffield presented the draft project recommendations for CMAQ funding for FY 2023/24 through FY 2027/28.

Mr. Sheffield asked for questions.

Debbie Buckland asked if the SR 228 project is west of US 17.

Jim Knight responded the project is located on McDuff between Roosevelt Blvd. and I-10.

F. SMART NORTH FLORIDA UPDATE

Clayton Levins gave the following update.

- Working with LISC Jacksonville on a Property Appraisal Innovation project in Duval County. This would help the CDCs and community housing developments with adopting technology solutions to raise appraisal values in the underserved communities. LISC will also create their own IP around artificial intelligence to help with property appraisals.
- Formed a partnership with the University of Florida's Information Systems
 Department for Master Degree students to solve complex data projects for
 some of our non-profit and public sector entities within the region. For
 example, we have partnered with UNF's Hunger Network to perform a
 food sensitivity analysis.
- Formed a partnership with Hello Lamp Post out of the U.K. They have built a proprietary artificial intelligence communication system that would allow residents to communicate at the public sector and community level.
- Formed a partnership with Blue Vigil, a local start-up. They have a tethered UAV (unmanned aerial vehicle) that will fly to a specific height from an operating system on the ground. It will shine LED aerial lighting overhead, which will aid First Responders and lineman within our community.
- Debbie Buckland asked if Blue Vigil has any practical applications working anywhere at this time.
 - Mr. Levins responded that they are starting their BETA program with a few interested parties. One hurdle is the legislation in the State of Florida regarding drones. They are also working on deployment with some utility companies in the midwest.
- Spot Marking is a data aggregator that is applied to parking systems within communities with large parking infrastructures. Their objective is to aggregate data into one repository.

- Fracta Al leverages machine learning to rapidly identify weaknesses in water pipe networks, understand the impact of an unplanned failure, and improve the reliability of the infrastructure.
- A representative of Hello Lamp Post will present to the TPO Board in September.
- A representative of StormSensor will present on their Neptune Beach project in October.
- In November, TrainFo will present the findings from their pilot program with FDOT for the US 17 and San Juan Avenue area.
- Spot Marking will present to the TPO Board in December.
- Beginning in September, SNF will hold quarterly stakeholder meetings with a possible virtual option.

G. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

- Jeff Sheffield informed the Board that the Smart St. Augustine project is a Smart City Lab. Last year, FDOT's Central Office selected this project as one of three projects to submit for the federal RAISE Grant. The project was not selected; however, FDOT programmed \$7.5 million in the Work Program for this project. The project was submitted again for the RAISE Grant this year and was awarded \$15.3 million. This cut the FDOT's match in half and doubled the overall money for the project.
- The North Florida TPO is the host agency for the North Florida Clean Fuels Coalition. This past week, the Coalition passed their re-designation with flying colors. Mr. Sheffield thanked Elizabeth DeJesus and Marci Larson (Co-Directors) for all their hard work.
- Debbie Buckland congratulated the Clean Fuels Coalition on their redesignation.

Ms. Buckland commented that last week several JTA Board Members attended the seminar for transit board members hosted by APTA. While there, we found that there was a buzz nationwide around North Florida for our transit community. Ms. Buckland congratulated the group.

Chairman Bolla thanked Mr. Sheffield and his group for the great job that they are doing.

H. SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION'S REPORT

Secretary Evans gave the following update.

- FDOT in Lake City will host Secretary Perdue and his executive team for the monthly coordination meeting.
- To date, FDOT has \$1.7 billion in project letting this year.
- The First Coast Expressway project is 26 percent ahead of schedule despite the supply chain issues, etc.
- Safety Studies say that 94 percent of accidents are due to driver behavior. FDOT will be conducting an outreach program to attempt to change driver behavior on our roadways. Our target group is male drivers between 18-24 years old. Secretary Evans asked the group for assistance in getting FDOT in front of students, civic organizations, etc.

Chairman Bolla commented that he may help getting in with the school system.

• Chairman Bolla asked how the FDOT deals with overruns on their projects, and what are they doing to overcome inflation in project costs.

Secretary Evans responded that FDOT does not need all the money in the bank before the letting date of the project. We fund the five-year program. Contingency is at an all-time low. Our biggest issue is aggregate and supply chain.

I. AUTHORITY REPORTS

Fernando Acosta-Rua – **Jacksonville Aviation Authority** – Demolishing the check-in lanes will begin in November with completion in February 2024. It will move lanes from eight to nine with three automated systems that will increase the thru-put. Concourse B bidding will begin this month and the project should be completed in August 2025.

 Daniel Bean asked if there are any impacts to Jacksonville as a result of flights being cut.

Mr. Acosta-Rua responded that Breeze Airlines has had to cut back their flights and their new planes are not yet in circulation as they are waiting to complete the FTA process.

Daniel Bean - JAXPORT - Turned vessels in Blount Island, which saved fuel and pilot fees, etc. Added 250,000 square feet of cold storage warehouse by

partnering with FlexCold and Axionlog. JaxPort is hosting the Paper Product Industry in September 18-20 for their Transportation Symposium. International Longshoreman Association scholarship fund awarded over \$50,000 to 21 area students. Six are first time college recipients.

Greer Gillis (for Ari Jolly) – Jacksonville Transportation Authority - JTA received three First Place awards from APTA in the first round of the 2022 AdWheel Awards. The AdWheel Awards go to APTA member systems for outstanding marketing and communications efforts that contributed to strategic organizational goals. We competed in the Group 2 category, against similar peer systems with annual ridership between 4 and 20 million passengers in 2019. Nearly 300 entries were evaluated and selected by industry experts. Ultimately, we received first place in the following categories:

- o Best Electronic Media on COVID-19
- o Best Comprehensive Campaign on COVID-19
- Best Partnership to Highlight Transit Needs and Funding

For the "Best Electronic Media on COVID-19" category, our award-winning television show *JTA Making Moves* was honored for providing the community and industry colleagues with insight into the JTA's commitment to providing transportation services while maintaining a safe environment for its employees and customers.

Our communications and marketing efforts for the Authority's "Wellness on Wheels" initiative was recognized in the "Best Comprehensive Campaign on COVID-19" category. Wellness on Wheels is a multipronged partnership with Agape Family Health Center to provide greater access to COVID-19 tests and vaccinations. The JTA converted four retired 40-foot buses and a paratransit vehicle into mobile COVID-19 clinics to assist Agape Family Health Center. By providing vaccines for over 12,000 people, the campaign garnered national attention.

Finally, the Jobs for Jax initiative was awarded a First Place prize in the "Best Marketing and Communications to Highlight Transit Needs and Funding Category." This work highlights the JTA's partnership with the City of Jacksonville to extend and expand Duval County's Local Option Gas Tax to fund more than \$1 billion in new infrastructure funding.

The top first place winners in all categories will compete for the Grand Prize Awards, which will be presented at APTA's TRANSform Conference in Seattle in October 2022.

In coordination with the International Association of Public Transport known as UITP, we will be hosting the UITP North America Forum which is an annual

conference aimed to offer the North America region UITP's worldwide resources for global connectivity and knowledge, bringing together the most current information and developments for our urban transit industry. This year's forum will focus on multimodal transportation including automated, shared, and micromobility services, and it will also feature several in-person networking opportunities, connecting industry suppliers and transit agencies. The forum will be held at the DoubleTree by Hilton Hotel in Downtown Jacksonville from September 27-29, 2022.

Mike Cole – Nassau County Ocean Highway and Port Authority – In June we have had highest tonnage in four years. Butch Gilbert is our new Director of Operations. Mr. Gilbert is with Savage Services, who have over 200 locations and 4000 team members. They have acquired Nassau terminals and worldwide transportation. We now have a new owner and operator and are very excited.

Matt Schellhorn (for Captain Jeff Hill) U.S. Navy – Mayort is hosting a major maritime exercise. Under the exercise scenario, participants from air, land, special forces and maritime components have formed a multinational force to defend the Panama Canal under a United Nations Security Council resolution. The scenario played out as simulated operations in the canal and its regional waters in both the Eastern Pacific Ocean and the Caribbean Sea. NAS Change of Command will take place August 19. Captain Cantu will relieve Captain Hill.
